

CHANGES TO THE HOUSING TEAM

As part of a review of staffing arrangements across the City of London Corporation, the Housing team is making some changes to local estate teams and some of its 'back office' services.


WHAT IS CHANGING?

We are phasing out certain job roles and introducing some new ones, but overall staffing levels on your estate are not changing.

The current Estate Manager and Estate Officer posts, which deal with both housing and estate matters, are being phased out. We are bringing in new specialist job roles which will have clearer responsibilities. These new posts will continue to be based locally on your estates.

The changes are intended to make it clearer who is responsible for what, and to improve customer service and estate standards on City of London estates.

CITY OF LONDON HOUSING STAFF STRUCTURE



Responsible for resident property and tenancy/ lease issues

Responsible for communal parts of the building and grounds



RESIDENT SERVICES OFFICERS

Will take the lead on helping residents with housing related issues, essentially anything relating to your home or tenancy. These staff will also promote resident involvement and engagement, for example supporting the work of Residents' Associations on your estate. There will be five Resident Services Officers, covering the same patches as the current Estate Managers:

- Avondale Square Estate
- Golden Lane Estate
- Middlesex Street, Dron House and Windsor House
- Southbank Estates, Sydenham Hill, William Blake Estate and Horace Jones House
- York Way and Holloway Estates



ESTATE SUPERVISORS

Will manage Porter/Cleaners and Gardeners and will focus on cleaning, caretaking, and gardening services on your estate. They will be part of the new Estate Services team, which will be led by the Estate Services Manager. There will be one Estate Supervisor for each of the areas listed above.



GARDENERS

Will be based on many estates, to carry out grounds maintenance and light landscaping duties. We are bringing all gardening services in-house and ending gardening contracts.



CLEANING STAFF

Some former Resident Estate Officer posts will be replaced with full time cleaning staff, following recent retirements in the team.



RENT AND ARREARS STAFF

The Rents Team and our Income Recovery Officers are being brought together in one team – the Income Team. The Income Recovery Officers will now be managed centrally but will continue to be based at local estate offices, to ensure they are accessible to tenants.



RECRUITMENT TO NEW POSTS

Due to the changes across the Corporation, permanent recruitment was paused for a while. We have had temporary arrangements in place to provide cover on some estates and we are now starting to recruit permanent staff to any existing vacancies, and the new roles we have created. This is now well underway and we will continue to cover any vacancies using agency staff in the meantime.
